3] "Journaling" is a feature that helps protect the file system against power outages or hardware component failures, reducing the need for repairs. Journaling was first introduced in Mac OS X Server 10.2.2, then to the non-server OS in Mac OS X 10.3 Panther. This document explains some of the benefits of using this feature and how it works. 4] Directions to Adam's house:

DIRECTIONS

From Portland

Take I-295 to I-95; proceed north to the second Gardiner exit that is the last exit before the toll, (old exit 28) (Route 126, Gardiner). Turn right toward Gardiner at end of ramp. Follow "from the Interstate exchange directions" below.

From Lewiston

Take the Turnpike north, past the Gardiner barrier toll. Take the first exit after the toll (Exit 14B). Turn left toward Gardiner at end of ramp. Follow "from the Interstate exchange directions" below.

OR

Take Sabattus Street (Route 126 north) through Monmouth and Litchfield until you get to the overpass where the Turnpike and I-95 cross. Follow "from the Interstate exchange direction" below.

From Waterville and points north

Take I-95 south until the Interstate splits from the Turnpike. Stay on I-95 by taking Exit 14A. Go through the toll booth and take your first exit, immediately on your right (Exit 28 --Route 126 Gardiner). Turn left toward Gardiner at end of ramp. Follow "From the Interstate exchange directions" below.

INTERSTATE EXCHANGE DIRECTIONS: You are now on Route 126 heading toward Gardiner. Proceed 2.0 miles. As you are traveling this 2-mile route, you will go past Gardiner Middle School on left, and then notice a body of water on right. Make a left at New Mills Market/Kenoco Station. This is West Hill Rd. You can see the green metal bridge into Gardiner. If you go over the bridge, you've gone too far.

Proceed on this road past Gardiner High School. The road is 0.8 miles long and ends at a T-intersection with Highland Avenue. Make a left.

Highland Avenue becomes High Street. After proceeding 1.2 miles, you will go over the interstate. Our house is 0.9 miles farther on your right. We are the first house after Rabbit Ridge Road. Our number is 751 and is on the mailbox. Mailbox numbers are sequential.

From Gardiner or Route 201 to the north, or Route 9 to the north, take Bridge Street toward Gardiner at the Randolph bridge. Go past Rite Aid, Cumberland Farms and McDonalds. Take a right onto Highland Avenue at the Irving Station. Proceed 2.0 miles to I-95 overpass. Our house is 0.9 miles farther on your right. We are the first house after Rabbit Ridge Road. Our number is 751 and is on the mailbox. Mailbox numbers are sequential. PHONE 582 5248
